

**SUMMER ST-ARTS PROGRAM
GENERAL REGULATIONS**

Please review the following regulations with your student. **Both of you should sign at the bottom indicating your understanding and compliance.**

1. **Each student agrees to the attendance policy of committing to the entire three-week program. Failure to comply may jeopardize eligibility for the program.**
2. While attending the Summer ST-ARTS Program, each student is subject to all rules and regulations of the Student Handbook of their school. *Students are also subject to disciplinary action by their local school district for infraction of rules.*
- 3) While on the Winthrop University campus, each student will be subject to all rules and regulations of the Summer ST-ARTS Program as defined by administration, faculty and staff. *Nametags are to be worn at all times.*
- 4) No student is to leave the Winthrop University campus at any time during the scheduled program meeting times without prior approval from the program office.
- 5) **Students ARE NOT to cross Cherry Road at any time.** Students needing to cross Oakland Avenue to go to Dacus Library will be escorted at all times.
- 6) **Students are not to schedule vacations or routine medical or dental appointments, etc. during the program.** *Excessive absences will result in expulsion from the program and the loss of the privilege of attending in subsequent years.*
- 7) Unauthorized visitors who are not program participants are not permitted to attend program classes or activities. *Students should NOT invite friends to accompany them during the day.*
- 8) Skateboards ARE NOT permitted on the Winthrop campus during the program. Students are not to use cell phones during class meeting times.

Failure to comply with these regulations will result in immediate dismissal from the program and any other disciplinary action the local school district deems appropriate. Students dismissed from the program ARE NOT eligible to return to the program in subsequent years.
